ORDER

23rd January 2024 (Through Video Conferencing)

- The MahaRERA Authority had issued a show cause notice dated 24.11.2023 to the Respondent above named for publishing an advertisement in Pudhari Newspaper in respect of their real estate project situated at Navi Mumbai without registering the said project with MahaRERA Authority.
- 2. The Promoter, inspite receiving the show cause notice dated 24.11.2023, failed to show cause to the same within the time period stipulated in the said show cause notice.
- 3. In this regard, a hearing was scheduled on 23.01.2024 through video conferencing as per the MahaRERA Circular No. 27/2020 and MahaRERA Order No. 593/2023, wherein the Respondent could appear through its representative and make its submissions.
- 4. However, during the course of the aforementioned hearing, the Respondent failed to appear even though the notice of hearing and the link for the hearing was duly served upon the Respondent.

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5. In this regard, it is necessary to peruse the provisions of Section 3 of the RERA which reads as under:

"3. No Promoter shall advertise, market, book, sell or offer for sale, or invite persons to purchase in any manner any plot, apartment, or building, as the case may be, in any real estate projector part of it, in any planning area, without registering the real estate project with the Real Estate Regulatory Authority established under this Act."

- 6. An interpretation of Section 3 reveals that the Promoter is legally obligated to refrain from engaging in activities such as advertising, marketing, booking, selling, or inviting individuals to purchase any plot, apartment, or building unless the real estate project in question has been duly registered with MahaRERA.
- 7. In the present case, it has been established that the Respondent had published an advertisement in Pudhari Newspaper, without fulfilling the requisite registration process with MahaRERA Authority for the advertised projects.
- 8. Therefore, it is hereby directed that a written communication be sent to CIDCO noting that no additional authorisation be granted for the said project until such time as the aforementioned project has been duly registered with MahaRERA Authority. Moreover, it is directed that the Registration and Stamp Office shall be instructed to abstain from registering any sale agreements within the said project, until such time as the project is duly registered with MahaRERA Authority, in accordance with the stipulations outlined in the said Act.
- 9. With the above directions, the present case stands disposed of.
